1. <b>Point of View error (POV):</b> inconsistent narrative voice					
2. <b>Passive Voice (PV):</b> subject of the sentence is not doing the action in the sentence					
3. <b>Sentence Boundary Errors</b> (comma splice, run-on, fragment)					
4. <b>Verbs error:</b> tense; wrong/missing ending; doesn't agree with subject; form					
5. <b>Missing or misplaced possessive apostrophe</b>					
6. <b>Spelling (SP)</b>					
7. <b>Other</b>
